If There's Ever Been a Time to Fight for Women and Children, the Time is Now.



We have been fighting around the clock to stop petition circulators who are working to gather the needed 35,000 signatures to make abortion legal for up to nine months in our state. If they win, come November 6, 2024, parental notice for a minor undergoing abortion will be gone. Basic medical and safety protections for women will be gone. The requirement for abortion doctors to be licensed will be gone.

We desperately need your help. We've seen what has become of Minnesota and we do not want to be a haven for abortion evils in South Dakota.

Our wonderful front-line volunteers have been working to tell South Dakotans the truth about the radical abortion amendment. They have loyally spent their Saturdays at the Farmer's market, their weekdays at the courthouses and universities, showing up anywhere and everywhere they find petitioners advocating for abortion. These pro-life

fighters have done a tremendous job and I'm incredibly grateful for their strength and resolve. But we need more of them. We need you. We need to see the grassroots involvement in a much more personal and active way than ever before. Pro-life friends, we need to get to the front line and stop them from getting the signatures. For every pro-life volunteer we currently have, there are ten pro-abortion petitioners. They are well-funded and well-organized, but

here's the deal, we can beat back their radical agenda if we band together.

Everything from donating to the Life Defense Fund, to volunteering, to passing out flyers, to spreading the word in your churches and communities is essential if we're going to win this fight. We're a team.

When Nehemiah and his comrades began rebuilding Jerusalem's city walls, their enemies tried to divide them, deceive them, hurt them, and even kill them. What did they do in response? They kept BUILDING. They didn't pretend the threats weren't real or turn a blind eye to reality. No. They held a tool in one hand and a sword in the other.

We must do the same.

I won't sugar-coat this request for reinforcements. I'm asking you to step into the line of fire. You might be yelled at - you might have nasty things written about you on social media, but I know this movement and I know who you are: you are tireless fighters who are passionate about mothers and babies, and you won't be intimidated into silence.

November 6, 2024, will be too late, but today isn't. If we say we are pro-life, then let's rise to the occasion. Our South Dakota women and children need us. Let's show pro-abortion petitioners who we are and what we are made of. Let's not back down. Let's not give up. Let's not lose heart.

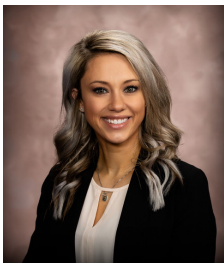

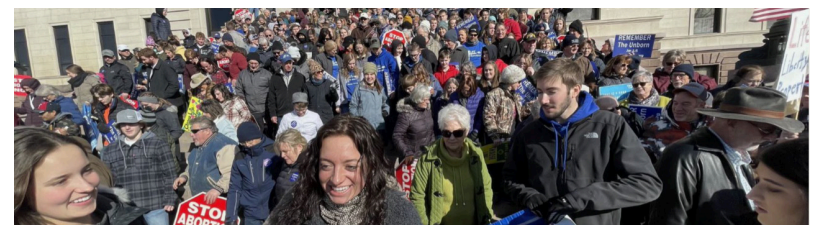

Roxie Johnson became a second-generation pro-life advocate in 1986 when her parents, who were active in the Tri-State Right to Life group in Belle Fourche, invited her to a series of meetings to discuss avenues of intervention for unborn babies who were being aborted nearby in a facility in Rapid City. Her passion for women and their unborn babies was ignited at one of the meetings where, for the first time, she heard the heart-wrenching testimony of a woman who had had a second trimester saline abortion. 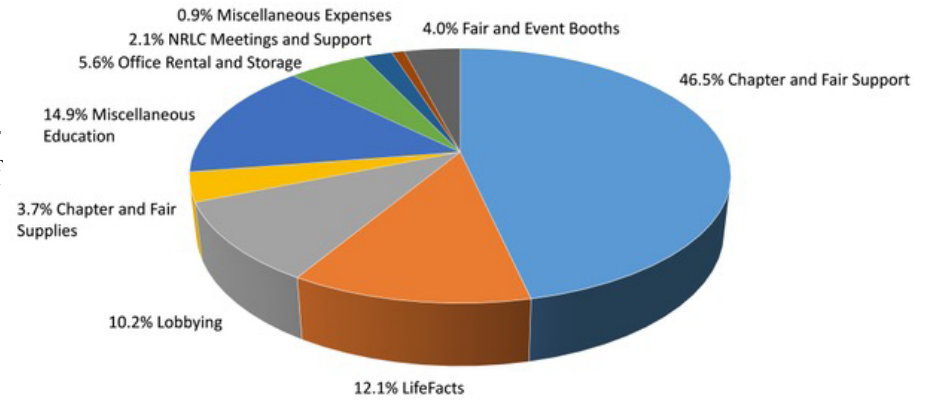

SDRTL Operates With a Flare of Financial Integrity

As we continue advocating for LIFE in 2023, let us take a look at how South Dakota Right to Life has worked to ensure that the most is made of every contribution that we have received this year and hope that you will partner or continue to partner with us as a sustaining member this year. So far in 2023, approximately 46.5% of your donations have gone toward providing staff in support of chapters, pro-life outreach, and coordinating exhibits and booths at fairs and other events including the convention coming up in Aberdeen this September. Lobbying for pro-life legislation each session in Pierre has taken up another 10.2% of our budget. The LifeFacts that you receive goes to more than 16,000 households and makes up 12.1% of this year's budget. A remaining 14.9% of donations are spent on miscellaneous education outreach, which includes fighting the abortion-until-birth petition. 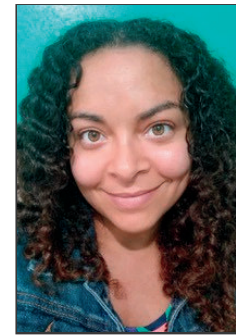
