We share the truth with people because we love them. Not to impose our will upon them, as some believe; but to show them that there is a better way. Do not hold back your love for people by watering down the message of life. It is critical that we stand boldly, in the name of love, family, and all that is good. You don't have to have the perfect words; you just need the courage to stand in the gap.

I wish I'd had the chance to talk with my friend before she made this decision. She may have changed her mind if she'd heard the truth about the life growing inside of her, and the support available to her. I wish that she hadn't felt so alone...she might still be here with us.

Over the past year and a half, Life Defense Fund volunteers have been standing right alongside petition circulators, telling South Dakotans the truth about the Abortion Amendment and encouraging citizens to decline to sign the Abortion Amendment petition.

For those volunteers and many others who observed pro-abortion activists circulating petitions during that time, one thing became very obvious: pro-abortion circulators have lied, been dishonest, and misled citizens into signing the Abortion Amendment Petition.

Some citizens signed the Abortion Amendment petition because the circulator made them believe the petition was pro-life. Others approached petition circulators asking to sign the petition to repeal the food tax,

but the circulator handed them Abortion Amendment petition instead! The South Dakota Attorney General even had to send a letter to the Abortion Amendment sponsor admonishing them for misleading South Dakotans about the Abortion Amendment.

Until recently, there was no legal process for people to withdraw their name from a petition. But during the legislative session, I sponsored and passed a bill that allows anyone who has been deceived by a petition circulator to take their name off of a petition.

So ask your family and friends, "Did you sign the Abortion Amendment petition? Did they tell you what it would really do? Did they tell you it would allow for abortion up to birth, take away parents' rights, and even ban womens' health and safety regulations for most abortions? Is that what you wanted to sign?"

On www.takeoffmyname.com you can learn how to easily fill out a form to take your name off of the abortion petition and how to submit the form to the Secretary of State.

SDRTL's 2023/2024 Legislative Scorecard Explanation

(*) Designates - Legislative Prime Sponsors



These Resolutions were Supported by SDRTL – Passed:

<u>SCR 602</u> (2023 *Bolin/Deutsch) A Resolution affirming the Legislature's support of the United States Supreme Court decision of Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization.

HCR 6008 (2024 *Cammack/Davis) An Act opposing an initiated measure to place the right to an abortion in the Constitution of South Dakota.

• These Bills were **Supported** by SDRTL – Passed & Signed by the Governor:

SB 55 (2023 *Wiik/Blare) An Act to prohibit ranked-choice voting.

<u>SB 75</u> (2023 *Wheeler/Bartels) An Act to revise provisions related to parental support for expenses related to pregnancy and childbirth.

HB 1224 (2024 *Rehfeldt/Tobin) An Act to require the creation of an informational video and other materials describing the state's abortion law and medical care for a pregnant woman experiencing life-threatening or health-threatening medical conditions.

HB 1244 (2024 *Hansen/Novstrup) An Act to provide a process to withdraw a signature from a petition for an initiated measure, constitutional amendment, or a referendum on a law in certain situations and to declare an emergency.


This Bill was Opposed by SDRTL and was Defeated in the Process:

<u>SB 210</u> (2024 *Nesiba/Duba) An Act to establish an individual's right to make autonomous decisions about the individual's reproductive health care, and to repeal provisions related to abortion.













As we continue on through the new year of 2024, let us take a look at how South Dakota Right to Life has worked to ensure that the most is made of every contribution that we have received this year and hope that you will partner or continue to partner with us as a sustaining member in 2024. So far in 2024 approximately 36.6% of your donations have gone toward providing staff in support of chapters, pro-life outreach, and coordinating exhibits and booths at fairs and other events including the convention. Lobbying for pro-life legislation each session in Pierre has taken up another 12.0% of our budget. The LifeFacts that you receive goes to more than 16,000 households and makes
